INVITATION CARDS

Each graduand is allowed one invitation card for two of his/her selected guests only. Graduands will be required to submit the names of the two guests they wish to invite for the ceremony and thereafter their invitation cards will be issued. Cards and gowns will be collected from 10th to 14th January, 2011. For Undergraduate programmes, graduands shall be required to pay shs **90,000/=**, shs **80,000/=** for Postgraduate Programmes, for PhD's the fee shall be shs **110,000/=**. Likewise for International students the fee should be an equivalent of **US\$ 170**.
