- us gives us a chance to reflect on where we have come from, where we are and where we wish to be as an institution in the next ten years.
- As Makerere University, we honor and acknowledge the contributions of the leaders of this great institution. Makerere bestowed her first endowment chair upon Prof. Ali Mazrui on 11th August 2009. We have also awarded honorary doctorates for exceptional leadership, with the most recent being the award of an Honorary Doctor of Laws to H.E Yoweri Kaguta Museveni, President of the Republic of Uganda and H.E Rashid Mfaume Kawawa (posthumous).
- Makerere University as the oldest and premier public institution of higher education in Uganda plays a vital role in supporting government educational programmes like UPE, USE and now Universal Advanced Level Education. Makerere University will continue to strategically position itself to:
 - a) Produce enough teachers to assist in the implementation of quality education in the country
 - b) Admit more students of Education, and thus produce more teachers especially science teachers so as to support the government policy on compulsory sciences at ordinary level.

I wish to thank the University Council, fellow members of Management, and staff, in particular the Dean and staff of Makerere University School of Education, for their contribution to the success of this occasion. I do pray that we follow in the footsteps of all the great men who have made Makerere University and Uganda in particular proud.
