Makerere University Special Graduation Ceremony

Makerere University will hold its Special Graduation Ceremony on Friday 22nd July 2011 in the Main Hall, Main Building. This is a fulfillment of the pledge made during the 61st Graduation Ceremony, held from 17th – 21st January 2011.

The Chancellor, Professor George Mondo Kagonyera will confer degrees and award diplomas to **1,190** graduands, of whom **705** are male and **485** are female. Out of the total number of **1,190** graduands, **eleven (11)** will receive PhDs.
