EITHER

- (a) HAVE THE UGANDA CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION WITH AT LEAST **(FIVE PASSES)**, OR ITS EQUIVALENT AND AT LEAST TWO PRINCIPAL PASSES AT ADVANCED LEVEL OBTAINED AT THE SAME SITTING. (FOR DAY PROGRAMMES, ONLY CANDIDATES WHO SAT A'LEVEL IN 2011, 2010 AND 2009 ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY. FOR EVENING, AFTERNOON, AND EXTERNAL PROGRAMMES, A CANDIDATE IS NOT RESTRICTED ON THE YEAR OF SITTING A'LEVEL.

OR

- (b) HOLD AT LEAST A SECOND CLASS OR CREDIT (OR EQUIVALENT CLASSIFICATION) DIPLOMA FROM A RECOGNISED INSTITUTION, RELEVANT TO THE PROGRAMMES APPLIED FOR.
