- Searching the Internet – search engines (Google Scholar, Google Earth etc), and specific databases (e-books, AGORA, OARE, HINARI/Pub Med, TEAL Blackwell, Emerald, EBSCO)
- Document Delivery Services (DDS)
- Management of multiple electronic files and word processing
- Professional citing and quotation
- Reference management using Endnote
- Scholarly Writing
- Presentation of research work
