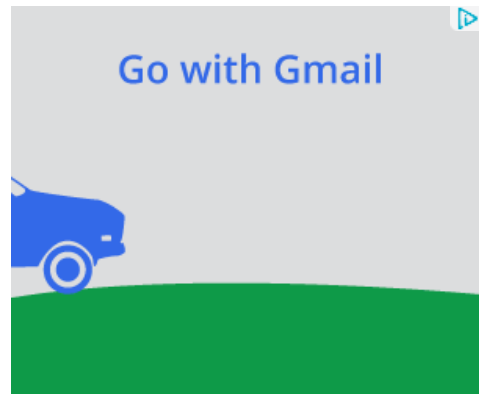


Makerere University To Renovate, Construct New Toilets

Makerere University administration has revealed plans in the next financial year to renovate all toilets in halls of residence and lecture rooms.

The revelation follows a petition tabled by Makerere University students before the Speaker of Parliament, Rebecca Kadaga, in which they complained bitterly over the poor state of toilets, as well as remittance of internship fees and limited access to the university hospital.

Appearing before the Social Services committee today, the Makerere administration, led by Vice Chancellor, Prof Venancius Baramureeba and his deputy, Dr. Lillian Tibatemwa, revealed that the university will in the 2012/2013 financial year set aside 1.3 billion shillings for the project, which will also see new toilets built.

According to the university's Estates manager, Fred Niwagaba, the current toilets are unable to cater for the increasing number of students, hence need for a contingency plan to construct new ones.

Niwagaba adds that the project will run for the next 3 years.

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
