President Yoweri Museveni of Uganda has said the forthcoming Presidential elections will be free and fair.

Speaking to Makerere University students today, Museveni said there will be no political intimidation, vote rigging and arrests of opposition politicians during or after polls. He has rubbished reports that the government has started harassing members of opposition in his favour. Museveni is contesting for president on National Resistance Movement ticket for the fourth time since 1996.

He says all political indications in Uganda show that majority of the people in the country still love Museveni. Museveni rose to power in 1986 after a five year war in which about 400,000 people died.
