Kyambogo University officially filed a protest with Varsity League Organisers seeking to overturn their result against Nkumba as they fight to move above Nkumba in pursue of the Varsity League title.

Sports department In Kyambogo say they have officially informed the organisers over Nkumba's fielding of an ineligible player despite mounting doubts over the protest.

If Kyambogo gets a favourable answer from the Organisers, they will move above Nkumba and leaving

Makerere University and MUBS with a huge mountain to climb to reach the summit.

The Buffaloes are protesting against Nkumba midfielder Meddie Muwaaya who was dressed in jersey number 11 who was in action when they clashed on Saturday at Kavumba Recreation Grounds.

Fresh evidence from the organisers indicates that all the documentations were provided but it was laxity between the team captains and the referees who failed to sort out the mess.

Despite the strong evidence against their protest, Kyambogo has gone ahead slap in the protest hoping to go top of the League standings.

"Pursuant to our statement released earlier yesterday, the Kyambogo Sports Department would like to announce that League Organisers have informed us that they are forwarding our mater to the Disciplinary Committee," a statement by Edu Ismail.

"In our communication to the Organisers, we requested them to review the November 10 League game Nkumba VS Kyambogo with specific reference to Nkumba's player Meddie Muwaaya.

"As stated in our earlier statement about the player, the Organisers had been looking at the relevant documentation and materials relating to the game, the player in review as well as the rules and regulations governing the University League.

"Once again, once the Organisers process is completed and the outcome communicated to us, we shall inform the public accordingly."

Kyambogo will move to the top of the League if awarded points while Makerere University will be second with three points behind Kyambogo if the League Organisers rule in favour of the Buffaloes.

Nkumba won the game against Kyambogo 1-0 in Kavumba three days ago which helped them to move to the top of the table standings.

The Buffaloes are protesting against Meddie who was instrumental in the game in Kavumba as he was not qualified to play in the match since he had no official documents to play in the League and this means the Nkumba player was not qualified to play in the game.

Nkumba currently are in the bliss points of the standings with two points than second placed Kyambogo and third placed Makerere and fourth placed MUBS while Uganda Martyrs University Nkozi are bottom with zero point
