Reconstruction of the Kyengera Catholic parish church is almost complete, with the consecration date now set for July 29, 2012. The new church, which markedly resembles Makerere University's St Augustine's chapel, is expected to seat 700 people, twice as many as the previous one. Monsignor Larry Kanyike, the Kyengera parish priest, and a committee led by former Finance Minister Gerald Sendaula, have now organized a fundraising luncheon set for April 29 at the church. Kanyike, also the Catholic chaplain at Makerere University, told parishioners on Easter Sunday that the luncheon was meant to raise Shs 50m needed for the wiring and lighting.

"You have already raised Shs 800m to bring the work to the present stage; can you now fail to raise Shs 50m to complete it?" Kanyike asked.

If the emphatic "No" that greeted Kanyike's question is anything to go by, the luncheon should be a success. Cards for the luncheon are on sale, at various prices – Shs 20,000; 30,000; 50,000; 100,000; 150,000 and 200,000. They can be obtained from the parish office and from members of the Sendawula-led committee.
