Makerere now move to the top of the League table having 13 points from six games two points more than Nkumba

Atiku struck a thunderous volley to put Makerere ahead after 12 minutes latching on to the poor marking by the defenders then struck another powerful header in the 23rd minute making it two goals for Makerere yet they had started very slowly in the expense of UMU who were making tremendous attacks in the first few minutes.

A 55th minute third goal by Makerere's David Ndihawe was enough to bury UMU's confidence and morale of coming back in to the game. A saying its not yet over until its over may have been implemented in to this game as UMU regrouped them selves and continued with their numerous attacks as before in the first half and this helped them a lot and came with a price of a consolation goal in the 59th minute by speed mar chant Alfred Mugalula.

From this point UMU grew stronger as their attacks looked promising from Alfred Mugalula team captain Moses Okot and Norbert Lotyang who had magnificent touches on the ball and they almost came to doubling their goal but Samson Kiirya's reflex actions in goal saved Makerere from conceding the second goal.

Fred Ndawula made his substitutions to boost the Makerere side which had lost the enthuthiasm and control over the game and brought in Tanga Obbo, Mahad Mbaziira and Oscar Bitum and this paid him dividends as trusted striker Dan Kasoma netted the fourth for MUK after he beat the off side trap and just looped over Mark Kibate, taking his goal tally to four goals with in the season.

And new entrant Oscar Bitum didn't disappoint his coach as he struck a magnificent goal from 27 yards which caught the keeper un a wear making it five for Makerere and the woes of Uganda Martyrs University seem to never end this season and this is their 7th loss in 7 matches and currently lying bottom of the University League
