The abstracts should outline aims, content and conclusions of the papers. They should include the title, author's name, affiliation, mailing address, e-mail address, telephone number and fax numbers and should not exceed 300 words.

The articles will be peer reviewed and published online and they should be in the following thematic areas;

The scope of the conference will be broad, covering aspects of engineering, architecture, art, industrial design, surveying and land management. The conference papers will focus on the following sub-themes:


- Improving the Performance of Infrastructure and Land Management.
