

Government Challenged To Grant MUBS Full Autonomy

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Government has been challenged to grant Makerere University Business School full autonomy if it's to develop.

The call was today made by the Makerere University chancellor Prof. Mondo Kagonyera, during a graduation ceremony at MUBS.

Though MUBS conducts teaching for degrees, it is not allowed to confer them, with its students sent back to Makerere University.

Prof. Kagonyera also appealed to government to support higher education saying there is need to shift focus from primary education.

He says no country can develop without strong higher education and post graduate, calling for allocation of more resources.

Kagonyera also challenged government to create employment for the thousands of graduates, emphasizing that it is its core responsibility.

Over 1,200 students have graduated with diplomas and certificates in various disciplines.

The best student was Michele Kiconco with a diploma in leisure and hospitality management, followed by one Cosmos Ogen with a diploma in business computing.

The 2 have been rewarded with 500,000 shs each and jobs at the university.

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
