

FDC In Fighting For EALA Positions Goes On

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FDC Vice President Salaamu Musumba is fighting to eliminate one of the candidates vying for the East African Legislative Assembly seat for which she is also a candidate.

Though there are six other candidates vying for the EALA seat, Musumba has zeroed in on Anita Among, a lecturer with Makerere University Business School and Kampala International University.

Musumba claims Among, also a member of the FDC fundraising committee, is bribing voters ahead of Tuesday's party primaries for the EALA elections.

However, the party has to overcome a hurdle at the East African Court of

Justice, where its lawyers are seeking an injunction to nullify earlier nominations by other political parties including NRM, DP and UPC.

The Vice President claims that Among is being sponsored by the ruling National Resistance Movement. At the party National Executive Committee meeting held on Thursday last week, Musumba insisted some members were beneficiaries of the bribery. However, no one came up to support her accusations against Among.

Speaking on phone, Musumba said she could not reveal the names today since elections are on Tuesday and does not want to tip off the perpetrators.

She has now vowed to bring a book with names of people who she says took the money whose sum is still unknown.

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
