The **Student Media Grants Program** (#SMGP) is an annual photojournalism grant awarded to students interested in using innovative methods to research and chronicle issues facing fragile and conflict-affected nations. Students are invited to create proposals describing their international travel, research idea, and photographic subjects. They should choose an international development area that reflects issues of food insecurity, health, education, land tenure, poverty, etc. as the basis for the proposal. Students do not have to be professional or experienced photographers to apply!
