INNOVATION SUB-CHALLENGES

Track 1: Scaling sustainable agricultural practices

Sub-challenge 1: Develop low cost environmentally friendly approaches and technologies to increase agricultural yield per acreage Sub-challenge 2: Develop contextually relevant technologies or approaches for post-harvest handling of produce

Track 2: Agricultural markets 2.0

Sub-challenge 3: Agricultural markets for the future that incentivize new types of networks and distribution models to catalyse enterprise and narrow the gap from farm to market

Sub-challenge 4: New models to promote produce-bulking, standardization, packaging, branding and farm-to-shelf produce traceability for increased farmer leverage in the market

Track 3: Livelihood diversification

Sub-challenge 5: Develop gender and age responsive models or platforms for launching highly profitable non-agricultural businesses in rural communities

Sub-challenge 6: Develop complementary 'pendulum' businesses that oscillate adaptively between dry and rainy seasons to sustain rural household incomes

Track 4: Financial Engagement and Inclusion

Sub-challenge 7: Develop new models or approaches to increase household savings
