The Royal Academy of Engineering announces the **Africa Prize for Engineering Innovation** is open for applications.

The prize aims to stimulate, celebrate and reward innovation and entrepreneurship in sub-Saharan Africa.

Applications are invited from engineers affiliated with a university or research institution in sub-Saharan Africa who have developed innovations that can provide scalable solutions to local challenges. Engineers from all engineering disciplines are invited to enter.

Shortlisted applicants will receive a six-month package of tailored support to help them achieve commercial success from their innovation.

The overall winner of the GBP 25,000 prize will be announced at a high-profile event in May 2016.

Applications close at **midnight on 29 June 2015**.
