THE ACADEMIC REGISTRAR, MAKERERE UNIVERSITY INVITES APPLICATIONS FROM UGANDAN, EAST AFRICAN, S. SUDAN AND INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS FOR THE UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES UNDER THE PRIVATE SPONSORSHIP SCHEME FOR THE 2015/2016 ACADEMIC YEAR

THE DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

EACH APPLICANT SHOULD:

EITHER

- (a) HAVE THE UGANDA CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (UCE) WITH AT LEAST **FIVE PASSES**, OR ITS EQUIVALENT AND AT LEAST TWO PRINCIPAL PASSES AT ADVANCED LEVEL (UACE) OBTAINED AT THE SAME SITTING. (FOR DAY PROGRAMMES, ONLY CANDIDATES WHO SAT A'LEVEL IN 2014, 2013 AND 2012 ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY. FOR EVENING, AFTERNOON, AND EXTERNAL PROGRAMMES, A CANDIDATE IS NOT RESTRICTED ON THE YEAR OF SITTING A'LEVEL. (DETAILED WEIGHTING SYSTEM FOR PROGRAMMES OFFERED AT MAKERERE UNIVERSITY FOR THE 2015/2016 ACADEMIC YEAR CAN BE VIEWED ON THE UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSIONS OFFICE NOTICEBOARD OR MAKERERE UNIVERSITY Website. www.mak.ac.ug)
- OR
- (b) HOLD AT LEAST A SECOND CLASS OR CREDIT (OR EQUIVALENT CLASSIFICATION) DIPLOMA FROM A RECOGNISED INSTITUTION, RELEVANT TO THE PROGRAMMES APPLIED FOR. **Certified copies of academic transcripts (not photocopies of certified copies) from the awarding Institutions MUST be attached to the application forms.**
