CALL FOR NOMINATION POSITION: CHANCELLOR

Makerere University is the premier University in Africa; a renowned centre of academic excellence, and a hub for research and innovations. The University provides world class innovative teaching, learning, research and services responsive to national and global needs.

Makerere University, the leading institution for academic excellence and innovations in Africa invites members of the public to nominate suitable candidates for the position of Chancellor.

Functions and Duties:

The Chancellor is the Titular Head of the University and presides at all assemblies, confers degrees, other academic titles and distinctions of the University.

Tenure of Appointment:

The Chancellor shall hold office for a period of four years but shall be eligible for re-appointment for one more term.

Qualification:

He/She must be a citizen of Uganda, aged not less than 55 years and not more than 75 years, at the time of nomination; and should hold at least a Bachelor degree (Honours) from a recognized institution of higher learning.

Personality:

He/She must be a person of high integrity and should have good public relations with the ability to market and internationalize the University.

Facilitation:

The successful candidate shall be facilitated whenever he/she comes to attend official duties but **shall not** receive regular emoluments.

Methodology of Nominations:

Members of the public with consent of the Nominee may send in letters of nomination, and curriculum vitae signed by the Nominee, copies of academic qualifications; testimonials; names and full addresses of three referees.
