END OF SEMESTER TWO - 2016/17

1. Semester two ends on Saturday, 24th May, 2017. Recess Term for eligible study programmes ends on 12th August 2017.

2. LAST MEAL & DEPARTURE

- a) Breakfast will be the last meal served **on Saturday 24**th **June 2017**, except for those with examination papers on Saturday and Sunday who should register with the Wardens who will in turn inform the Food Service Providers.
- b) All Resident Undergraduate Students, who are neither eligible to attend Recess Term nor have examination papers on Saturday and Sunday, should vacate University Residences by 12.00 Noon on that Saturday 24th June, 2017.
- c) All those with Recess Term should move to halls allocated for their accommodation as indicated in No. 3, below.

ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS DURING RECESS TERM: JUNE 24 – AUGUST 12, 2017

3.1 The following University Residences will remain open during Recess Term:

a) Galloway Hostel For Medical Students

b) Kabanyolo Hostel BSc Hort. I, BSc Agric. I and BSc FS&T I.

c) Livingstone Hall Students from Livingstone, Mitchell & Nsibirwa.

d) Lumumba Hall Students from Lumumba, Nkrumah & University.

e) Mary Stuart Hall Students from Africa, CCE Complex and Mary Stuart.

- 3.2 All Government-Sponsored students attending recess Term should move into the Halls of Residence. No Food and Living Out Allowance shall be paid out to students.
- 3.3 Privately sponsored students who wish to reside in Halls of Residence during Recess Term should contact the Warden's office for payment details.
- 3.4 Please note that Bed space is allocated to individual students and should not be co-shared, transferred, sublet or in any way abused. Fluking is strictly prohibited. Any student caught violating these guidelines and University regulations will be disciplined.

4. SECURITY OF PERSONAL AND UNIVERSITY PROPERTY

- a) Hand over **all University property** in your possession (such as: Room Keys, Sports & Games equipment, College Property, etc.) before proceeding to take the Semester Two Holiday Break.
- b) Ensure your security and that of your property as you proceed for the Holiday Break.
- c) Personal property stored anywhere in the University premises is done so entirely at the owners' risk.

5. START OF SEMESTER 1 - 2017/18

Semester 1 – 2017/18 starts on Monday, 21st August, 2017. Orientation for Fresh Students starts on Monday 14th August, 2017. Year 1 and Continuing Students resident in Halls of Residence should report to their Halls on Saturday 12th and 19th August 2017, respectively.

year will be issued before end of semester.
