## **Briefing on the Visitation Committee Report**

On the 29<sup>th</sup> of December 2017, the Visitation Committee handed over its Report to H.E. The President and Visitor to Makerere University in the presence of the Chancellor, Council Chairman and Members of Council, Top Management and representatives of MUASA, MASA, NUEI and the Students Guild.

At the meeting, HE the President and Visitor to Makerere University guided that a formal response to the report should be made by the University to the Ministry of Education and Sports.

The Visitation Committee highlighted a number of achievements as well as challenges faced by the University.

On behalf of Management, I commit to continue implementing what was recognized as being done well and to focus on areas where challenges were highlighted.

Allow me introduce to you a team that I have constituted to study the report with a view of;

1. Making a formal response that will be discussed extensively by the University Management and provide it

to the University Council which shall make a formal submission to the Hon. Minister of Education and Sports. This will contribute to the white paper development process.

- 2. Identifying areas for immediate implementation
- 3. Identifying areas that may need further clarification from the Ministry of Education and Sports.
