MakRun 2018 raises over UGX 130 Million in cash and Kind

The Second Edition of the Makerere University Endowment Fund Run (Mak Run) 2018 was held on Sunday, 25th March, 2018 with the help of staff, students, well-wishers and corporate companies raised a total of UGX 137, 295,000/= (One hundred thirty-seven million, two hundred ninety-five thousand shillings only) in both cash and pledges.

Makerere University Council inaugurated the Makerere University Endowment Fund (MakEF) Board of Trustees on 17th July 2014, to receive and /or mobilize funds for the benefit of University's research, teaching and learning, scholarships and the day-to-day running of the University. The MakEF Board of Trustees under its mandate to achieve long term financial sustainability for the University started the MakRun as one of the vehicles through which funds can be raised, with the Students' Center as its inaugural project.
