CALL FOR APPLICATIONS TO THE ERASMUS+ ICM BIDIRECTIONAL MOBILITY FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF

The College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (CAES), Makerere University in collaboration with the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences wishes to announce the Erasmus+ ICM mobility students' exchange scholarship fully funded for both undergraduate and M.Sc. graduate students registered by Makerere University under the College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences.

The two institutions have supported such exchanges in the theme learning for sustainable knowledge-intensive agriculture and agribusiness. The mobility is intended to offer opportunities to accelerate education and engagement of the youth in agripreneurial innovations that transcends cultural historical divides. This international exchange is also aimed at raising awareness and promoting experience, knowledge, ideas and skills necessary for taking action towards enhanced agricultural sustainability.

The mobility project will not only comprise bidirectional staff exchange for guest teaching and teacher training opportunities in the two universities but will also offer an opportunity for students from the two universities to be exposed to multiple options to take courses according to their study levels (BSc. or MSc.) or perform internships that are valid for university credits.

The scholarship will support 5 students to attend courses at SLU in 2019 and 2020. The program is designed to enable students transfer their ECTS credit/ credit units (CU) back to the home institution (MAK). This means that the courses that a student will undertake at SLU will be included on their academic transcripts. A list of the courses that will be offered during the exchange period can be found on the link below (A copy of the courses is displayed at the departments in College of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences).

Eligibility

- You should be a registered student at the College of agricultural and Environmental Sciences. For undergraduates you should be in at least 3rd year by the time of the exchange (2019). Masters students' should have completed a semester in university at the start of the exchange (2019).
- You should be ready to attend class in Sweden for 5 months

Requirements

1. You should provide a one page motivation letter clearly stating why you are the most suitable person to participate in this international exchange.
2. You should attach your testimonial indicating the courses you have undertaken during your studentship at Makerere University. There should be a clear indication of your CGPA and the courses you have passed and those you are retaking.
3. You should provide a letter of reference from one of your lecturers (preferably one that has taught you in previous classes) during your studentship at MAK.

How to Apply

1. Submit your application package as a single file (motivation letter, copy of academic testimonials and reference letter) to office of the principal College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences by **17 00 h on Wednesday 26th September 2018**.
