**Re: Semester Extension**

This is in response to your letter to the Vice Chancellor dated 24<sup>th</sup> April 2019, seeking Semester Extension across all Colleges. Following my meeting this morning with you and members of the Guild Executive, I would like to emphasise that the Vice Chancellor had earlier written to all Colleges, requesting those that needed an extension to indicate so. Only three Colleges (LAW, CHUSS and CoVAB) responded and these were accordingly given a two (2) weeks Semester Extension approved by Senate and Council.

Further consultations within the Colleges indicate that teaching has been completed, coursework/tests have been administered and examinations are ready to be administered beginning Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2019. In the few isolated cases where students received coursework/tests late, arrangements have been made to allow submissions on a case by case basis as determined by the affected units. Regarding the College of Education and External Studies where students on the BA/BSc. Education programmes have overlapping courses offered and examined at the collaborating Colleges (CHUSS, CoNAS and CoBAMS), I am pleased to inform you that this matter has also been resolved and necessary adjustments made in liaison with the Colleges.

Therefore, this is to advise that the Semester Two Examinations timetable as earlier published by the relevant offices stands. There shall be no further extensions, except for LAW, CHUSS and CoVAB as earlier approved, whose examinations will begin on 13<sup>th</sup> May and end by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019.

I would like to urge you to communicate this message to the student community and request that we prepare for the upcoming examinations beginning Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2019.
