## Introduction

Makerere University in partnership with the Inter-University Council for East Africa (IUCEA) is calling upon qualified candidates from EAC to apply for the under-mentioned programmes under KFW funded Masters Scholarships.

- 1. Master in Public Infrastructure Management
- 2. Master of Statistics
- 3. Master of Science in Zoology (Options: Entomology, Parasitology, Wildlife Ecology & Management and Fisheries and Aquaculture)
- 4. Master of Science in Technology Innovation and Industrial Development

The EAC Scholarship Programme is an initiative by the East African Community (EAC), the Inter-University Council for East Africa (IUCEA) and German Development Bank-KFW. In 2018 when the EAC and IUCEA entered into a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with KFW geared towards the training of students within the EAC region. This Project aims at creating future change agents, who identify themselves with the integration agenda of the EAC and are willing to share economic and development-oriented expert knowledge. The goal of this initiative is to contribute towards training leaders that will foster EAC regional integration. This goal will be partly achieved through academic collaboration and an exchange programme between universities/Institutions within the EAC region, by encouraging students to study in countries other than their own. The project offers a comprehensive package including scholarships for masters programmes, internships, mentoring, networking events and further leadership training activities. The programme will include a minimum 30 percent female students in order to support women's participation and enhance gender equality. IUCEA and Makerere University, hereby invites applications from students who are citizens of the East African Community (EAC) Partner States to apply for the KFW funded Masters Scholarships.

Duration of the scholarship: 2 years.

## 1. Master's in Public Infrastructures Management

The following specific admission criteria apply for MPIM program.

- i) A good first degree of at least lower second class (Honours), or its equivalent from a recognized University.
- ii) Proven full-time professional experience of at least 2, years at managerial/ supervisory level or policy-decision making position in a government, parastatal organ, international organisation or non-governmental organization (Applicants should attach a 2-page short CV, referee recommendations and certified copies of certificates and academic transcripts

## 2. Master of Statistics

- i) A first degree in statistics combined with Economics or Mathematics or any other allied subject, of at least Lower Second Class or its equivalent from a recognized University
- Applicants must have a strong background in Statistics, Statistics with Economics or Mathematics with several papers in Statistics.
- iii) Candidates with lower qualifications in relevant subjects who have shown academic growth may also be considered.
- iv) Candidates who have a postgraduate diploma in Statistics of at least class two may be exempted from Part I of the M. Stat. Programme.

# 3. Master of Science in Zoology (Options: Entomology, Parasitology, Wildlife Ecology & Management and Fisheries and Aquaculture

Admission requirement to MSc Zoology, the candidates should:

- i) Have at least a Second Lower Class in the field of Biological Sciences including but not limited to Fisheries, Parasitology, Conservation biology, Aquaculture, Entomology, Wildlife, Agriculture, Veterinary, Education (Science), Environmental Science from a recognized University. Candidates who are a holder of a third class degree may be admitted only after providing evidence of academic growth and maturity in the desired field of study.
- ii) All other admission requirements and regulations of Makerere University apply.

# 4. Master of Science in Technology, Innovation and Industrial Development

- i) All students must have a bachelor's degree of second class lower division and above from a recognized university in the field of Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Agricultural Engineering, Telecommunication Engineering, Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Food Science and Technology, Construction, Industrial Chemistry, Manufacturing, Mining and any related courses.
- ii) One year relevant work experience and recommendation from reputable individual or organization.
- iii) All other admission requirements and regulations of Makerere University shall apply
