RE: SALARY ENHANCEMENT FOR TEACHING AND NON TEACHING STAFF IN PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES


Reference is made to several communications from the Forum for Academic Staff in Public Universities (FASPU) and Public Universities Non-Teaching Staff Executive Forum (PUNTSEF) giving Government notice to withdraw labour w.e.f 1st August 2019 if their salaries are not enhanced.

Further reference is made to the meeting convened by the First lady and Minister for Education and Sports with Vice Chancellors of Public Universities on 31st July 2019 at Nakasero State House.

The above mentioned meeting was also attended by the Minister for Public Service, the Minister of State for Public Service, Minister of State for Investment, Minister of State for Primary Education, University Secretaries and Technical Staff from the Ministries of Public Service, Education and Sports and Finance, Planning and Economic Development. The meeting resolved that:

- Government has identified UGX 15 billion to address salary enhancement in the Public Universities and Degree Awarding Institutions.
- 2. The 15 billion will cater for the enhancement for both teaching and non-teaching staff.
- 3. The enhancement will take effect in the 2nd quarter of FY 2019/2020.
- 4. Ministry of Public Service and Ministry of Education and Sports will work with institutions to ensure equitable allocation and distribution of the UGX 15 billion.

The purpose of this letter therefore is to request you to communicate to all the staff under your jurisdiction to call off industrial action in light of Government's commitment to enhance salaries for all public universities' staff in a phased manner until the level pledged by H.E the President is fulfilled.
