

E-JUST TICAD7 African Scholarship for STI

1. Background

At TICAD7 meeting, 2019 in Yokohama, Mr. Shinzo Abe, Prime Minister of Japan mentioned "At the Egypt-Japan University of Science and Technology and at Kenya's Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology, we will foster 5,000 young people who will advance STI into the future.¹" at the plenary session. The scholarship program for African students at E-JUST was discussed at the bilateral talk by head of states of Egypt and Japan then it was mentioned in "Yokohama Plan of Actions 2019²".

2. Outline of Scholarship Program

(1) Objective:

- To develop high quality human resources in the field of STI toward future African STI network and beyond

(2) Number of Students:

- Approximately 150 post graduate students, intake over 3 years distributed on several batches

(3) Eligibility

- Applicants should be under 30 years old at Sep. 1, 2020
- Applicants shall be researchers or instructors who belong to universities or research institutions in Africa and who needs to obtain M.Sc. degree, or top-class undergraduate students who are expected to be researchers or instructors by those universities

(4) Tentative Schedule

- Mid December 2019: Call for application
