**RESUMPTION OF TEACHING AND LEARNING ACTIVITIES FOR FINAL YEAR STUDENTS IN THE COLLEGE OF HEALTH SCIENCES FOR 2019/2020 ACADEMIC YEAR**

THIS IS TO INFORM ALL FINAL YEAR STUDENTS OF THE COLLEGE OF HEALTH SCIENCES THAT TEACHING AND LEARNING ACTIVITIES WHICH WERE HALTED FOLLOWING THE CLOSURE OF EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS IN A BID TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19, WILL RESUME ON SATURDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> OCTOBER 2020.

YOU ARE THEREFORE REQUIRED TO REPORT TO THE DEAN OF STUDENTS FOR ACCOMODATION ON 3<sup>RD</sup> OCTOBER 2020 AND TO YOUR RESPECTIVE DEANS IN THE COLLEGE OF HEALTH SCIENCES ON 5<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2020 FOR DETAILED ACADEMIC AND HEALTH RELATED INFORMATION.

NOTE THAT YOU MUST STRICTLY ADHERE TO THE STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES PUT IN PLACE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH TO COMBAT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 WHICH INCLUDE AMONG OTHERS:

- MANDATORY WEARING OF A CLEAN MASK COVERING MOUTH AND NOSE
- SOCIAL DISTANCING
- WASHING OF HANDS REGULARLY AND/ OR SANITIZING HANDS
