

Building capacity for REDD+ in East Africa for improved ecosystem health and for sustainable livelihoods in Eastern Africa (REDD-EA), Grant No. UGA-13/0019

The REDD-EA project's goal is to **contribute to reduced greenhouse gas emissions** and **improved ecosystem health** for sustainable **livelihoods** in Eastern Africa.

The project contributes to the UNFCCC and the REDD+ multilateral policy.

The **Project Purpose** is to strengthen the capacity for education and research on climate change and REDD+ at Makerere University and the University of Dar es Salaam.

The anticipated **Project Outputs** are to:

1. Develop adequate human capacity for REDD+ in Ugandan and Tanzanian Higher Education Institutions developed
2. Create functional and Specialized training programs on REDD+
3. Create research capacity for REDD+ and evidence based results for policy on REDD+
4. Develop networks and partnerships between academic, research institutions and CSOs

This project is funded by the Norwegian Programme for Capacity Development in Higher Education and Research for Development (NORHED).

The project started in 2014 and will run up to December 2020.
