Course Content:

The content will include:

- ✓ The Qualitative research paradigm
- ✓ Generating qualitative research data
- \checkmark Making a qualitative data analysis plan, linking research questions with the analysis
- \checkmark Deductive and inductive coding: developing a codebook to guide the analysis
- ✓ Computer-Assisted Qualitative Data analysis (CAQDAS) e.g. Nvivo or Atlas.Ti
- ✓ Setting up a project e.g. in Nvivo or Atlas Ti
- ✓ Importing data into the software (e.g. transcripts, audios and videos)
- ✓ Qualitative data analysis approaches (thematic analysis, content analysis, analytical induction)
- ✓ Creating codes & a codebook (deductive analysis) or emerging themes (inductive coding)
- ✓ Coding the data (assigning codes to chunks of text): drag and drop, use of menu, use of ribbon icons
- ✓ Exploring and querying your data: text & code queries
- ✓ Data visualization e.g. network analysis, word trees
- ✓ Interpretation of qualitative the data out puts
- ✓ Criteria to assess the validity of qualitative research
- ✓ Writing qualitative research results (quotations, tables)
- ✓ Triangulation of data
