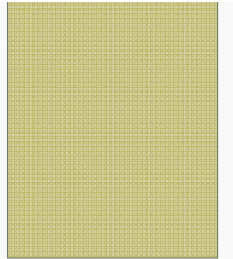

- It has 12,000 sq. meters and has sitting capacity of 3,980
- Due to COVID- 19, it can only accommodate 1,200 people at once.

## LIBRARY COLLECTIONS

### **The library collection consists of:**

- Over 400,800 monographs accessible at Main and college libraries.
- 45 E- Journal Databases.
- 11,699 titles of print serials/periodicals accessible at the main and college libraries.
