Contribution to Makerere University and Uganda – through Sida

Total support of SEK 756 million (USD100 million).

Has supported facilities:

- ❖ The sida supported IT facilities at Makerere University the best in the continent outside South Africa.
- Cross-cutting laboratory at CHS that provided modern training
- ❖ Demographic Surveillance Site (DSS) in Iganga and Mayuge districts
- Geographical Information System (GIS) lab
- Library resources and Services.

Sida has been monumental and critical to the realisation of our core functions of teaching and learning, research and innovations, and partnerships and networking:

A towering number of our staff have received PhD and Masters training through Sida funding:

- ✓ Since 2000 when the cooperation began, <u>over 300 staff have completed</u> PhDs
- ✓ Over 200 have completed masters degrees.
- ✓ We will have trained 450 PhDs by the time the programme ends.
- ✓ More than 60% of our staff now have PhDs.
- ✓ By the end of the program, 80% of our staff will have PhDs and everybody else will have a Masters

Sida has made a huge contribution to reviving and pushing Makerere higher.
