## RE: PAYMENT OF FOOD AND LIVING OUT ALLOWANCES FOR SEMESTER II

Reference is made to the communication from the University Bursar dated 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2020 regarding the payment of food and living out allowances for the second semester of academic year 2019/2020.

This is to inform you that the process of payment for food and living out allowances has commenced. This process involves transfer of funds from the Integrated Finance Management System (IFMS) to the Subvention Account in Stanbic Bank from where payments shall be made directly to the individual student bank accounts.

The funds are expected to begin reflecting on individual student bank accounts by early next week, depending on the bank clearance processes.
