Good Clinical Practice & ICH – GCP Course

Background

Makerere University College of Health Sciences within its Clinical Trials Unit (CTU) is organizing a Good Clinical Practice (GCP) course. This GCP course is a full time two-days online training with certification on successful completion, and acknowledged by the Uganda National Council for Science and Technology (UNCST). The course covers the history and background to research involving human participants, and a comprehensive review of the guidelines and regulations for protection of human participants involved in clinical research. The course also covers the relevant local and international regulations and guidelines governing clinical research. It offers an essential foundation for anyone involved or wanting to participate in clinical research. A basic understanding of GCP is a pre-requisite as well as current and or past involvement in clinical research and clinical trials in Uganda.

Target Group

The GCP course is targeted at investigators from hospitals and research institutes, research nurses, clinical trials support staff e.g., staff working in contract research organizations, ethics committee members as well as those seeking to develop a career in clinical research. Participants are strongly advised to obtain a letter of support from their employers or supervisors endorsing them to pursue the course. Certificates will be awarded at completion of the full two days' training.

Payment subsidized course fee of **Uganda shillings 250,000/=** is payable. This will contribute towards training materials, Facilitation fees, Internet Data and zoom fees for the whole course.
