RE: **ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES**

1. ATTACHEMENT TO HALLS OF RESIDENCE

All undergraduate students shall be attached to a Hall of Residence as part of their identity. This DOES NOT AUTOMATICALLY ENTITLE A STUDENT TO BED SPACE IN THE HALLS OF ATTACHMENT INDICATED ON THEIR ADMISSION LETTER.

2. GOVERNMENT SPONSORED STUDENTS

(a) Automatic Accommodation

All students admitted through the Direct Entry Scheme to the study programmes listed below (i. – xix) may **be accommodated** in the Halls of Residence to which they are attached as indicated on the admission letter, subject to availability of bed space. Eligible students, who for very strong reasons, are **not able to take up the accommodation offered to them** should inform the Dean of Students in writing before close of business on Monday 7th August, 2017.
