RE: SUSPENSION FROM MAKERERE UNIVERSITY FOR INDISCIPLINE

During its meeting held on 7th March 2022, the University Management received a report from the Dean of Students on the violent clashes between Mitchel and University Hall residents, which occurred at around 3:00 am on Sunday 6th March 2022. Management noted that several Mitchel and University Hall residents staged illegal roadblocks in the wee hours of the night. They broke over 150 windowpanes across 91 windows at both Mitchel and University Halls. Further assessments are ongoing to determine other University properties destroyed in the altercation.

By engaging in these acts, you and other students at large, were identified as participants in these violent clashes contrary to the Makerere University Students Regulations 8 (2) (a) and (b) and 8 (9) (b) (i), (viii), (ix), (x) and (xi). These acts included engaging in acts of hooliganism, mounting road blocks on campus, throwing stones at buildings and lighting fires on sign posts and roads on University Campus leading to the destruction of University property.

Because of your involvement in the above offensive acts and in order to ensure safety and security of the university community, you are hereby suspended with immediate effect from Makerere University until further notice, and subject to the outcome of the investigations. After the investigations are completed, you will be invited to appear before a disciplinary hearing on a date to be communicated to you in due course.

By copy of this letter, the Warden together with the Chief Security Officer are required to ensure that you vacate the University premises immediately to allow for commencement of investigations into this matter. You are further cautioned not to appear at Makerere University until a final decision in this matter has been reached. In the meantime, you will remain bound by this decision.
