ISRAEL AGROSTUDIES APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM 2022/2023

Applications are required from continuing undergraduate students registered under agriculture-related degree programs at Makerere University with the following specifications:

- a) Currently in the year preceding the final year (2nd year for a three year program, 3rd year for a four year program or 4th year for a five year program)
- b) Must be a Ugandan citizen who will not be more than 30 years of age by the end of August 2023. Male applicants are preferable based on the rigorous nature of the pre-training and the program. The applicant must attach a copy of his /her national ID as proof of Nationality and age).
- c) Medically healthy and able to pass an examination for general body and dental health, body mass index of at least 17, HIV status, Hepatitis B and tuberculosis. Completion of COVID-19 vaccination is a must.
- d) Physically fit enough to complete rigorous fitness training of one month as a pre-requisite to performing intense labor in Israel.
- e) Must possess an East African passport that is valid until the end of August 2023. Applicant must attach a copy of the data page of the passport).
- f) Should be able to pay the non-refundable program fees (USD 900) in two installments (First installment of USD 215 will be immediately after pre-selection prior to reporting for medical examination and physical fitness training and the second installment of USD 685 will be paid after completion of the medical examination and physical fitness training). The 900 USD is to cater for the following:
 - i. A one-way air-ticket to Israel (USD 600),
 - ii. Medical examination at the Makerere University Hospital (USD 100)
 - iii. Physical fitness training by Uganda Police (50 USD)
 - iv. Pre-departure COVID-19 test (USD 60)
 - v. Coordination fee (USD 50)
 - vi. Passport courier service (USD 10)
 - vii. Visa photograph (USD 5)
 - viii. Program T-shirt for the orientation ceremony and departure to Israel (USD 5)
 - ix. Transport to the airport (USD 5)
 - x. Bank charges (USD 15)



- g) Must have permission from a parent or guardian to withdraw from the degree program for the duration of the Apprenticeship program and re-integrate on return from Israel, in accordance with the relevant University policies and procedures.
- h) Should have a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of at least 2.80, without any outstanding retakes at the time of applying for the program. Submission of an up-to-date testimonial to this effect is a must.

The deadline for submission is 5 pm on July 15, 2022.
