## **Eligibility**

This is open to post graduate students, in their final year of study at their respective University graduate programs.

## **Criteria for Selection**

- 1. Proof of admission to your university in the stated School or Faculty on a Master's programme
- 2. Should on normal progress
- 3. Preference will be made to the finalists in Masters
- 4. Demonstrate interest in research training and conducting research within the respective discipline.
- 5. Students on three (3) or four (4) year postgraduate programs should provide proof of normal progress for the initial years of training.
- 6. A letter of recommendation and support from the programmes Head of Department.
- 7. Plan for career development
- 8. Capacity towards attaining research leadership and international recognition in one's field.
- 9. Commitment to developing at least one manuscript for publication based on their research
- 10. Applicants with research concepts focusing on any one of the following aspects will have an added advantage:
  - Sickle Cell Disease (Clinical, Public Health, Psychosocial Biomedical aspects)
  - HIV/AIDS
  - Health Professions Education
