

A special issue publication from the GORILLA conference is planned to be executed with the African Geographical Review (AGR) Journal which is published by Taylor & Francis on behalf of the American Association of Geographers' Africa Specialty Group. The AGR impact score for 2022 is 2.68. About 10-12 outstanding manuscripts presented at the GORILLA conference will be considered for publication in the special issue, which is expected to come out in 2023. Interested authors will be requested to submit full manuscript by 30th November 2022. The manuscripts will go through a peer review process for quality control purposes.
