## REMARKS BY THE VICE CHANCELLOR, PROF. BARNABAS NAWANGWE AT THE PRESS CONFERENCE ANNOUNCING AICAD'S APPOINTMENT AS AFRICA OPEN SCIENCE PLATFORM NODE FOR THE EAST AFRICAN REGION ON 12<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2023 AT 9:00AM, COUNCIL ROOM

I welcome you all to this press conference, which provides a golden opportunity for Makerere University and the African Institute for Capacity Development (AICAD) to share with you a key milestone in the promotion of research and science in the East African region.

AICAD is a regional organization charged with linking university generated technologies to the communities to fight poverty with headquarters at Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology. AICAD has country offices located at Makerere University in Uganda, Sokoine University of Agriculture in Tanzania and Egerton University in Kenya.

Makerere University is a pioneer member and one of the regional hosts of AICAD. I am pleased to notify the media, stakeholders and the public at large that after a very rigorous and competitive process, the National Research Foundation (NRF) of South Africa has selected the African Institute for Capacity Development (AICAD) as a regional node for the African Open Science Platform (AOSP) taking charge of the East African region node.

I therefore congratulate AICAD's continental and national leadership upon being successfully appointed as a regional node for the African Open Science Platform (AOSP) by the National Research Foundation (NRF) of South Africa.
