The Office of the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Academic Affairs), through the School of Economics, Makerere University invites applications from suitably qualified candidates registered at Makerere University for the Mobility (Students' Exchange/ Residence) Programme at the European University Institute (EUI) in Italy, supported by the Erasmus+ Mobility Programme.

Eligibility:

PHD STUDENT

8 Slots for PhD students.

PhD student at Makerere from the following disciplines: Economics, History, Law (*with a strong focus on International Law and European Law*), Political and Social Sciences (*with an important focus on public policy, governance, international relations across different regions of the worlds*).

MASTER'S STUDENT

2 Slots for Master's students

Master's students (*offering a programme that covers course areas in international law, public policy, economics, gender studies, migration, peace & security*). The EUI has established a multidisciplinary Master's Programme in Transnational Governance (MTnG), which is very keen to host **2 Master's students** who wish to participate in the above courses. Please, note that MTnG receives mobility students during its third semester (September-December).

Tenure of each mobility:

Long: 2-4 months

Short: 5-30 days (Only PhD students are eligible for short term mobility)

Mobility Grant:

Long term:

- o Individual support: €850 per month + €820 for travel
- o Top-up for participants with fewer opportunities: €250 per month (*please see below more information about participants with fewer opportunities*)

Short term:

- o Individual support: €79 per day (*up to the 14th day of activity*) + €56 per day (*15th to the 30th day of activity*) + €820 for travel
- o Top-up for participants with fewer opportunities: €100 (*for mobilities with duration of 5-14 days*) or €150 (*for mobilities with duration 15-30 days*)

Mode of application:

Interested individuals should submit a *letter of application* with *Curriculum Vitae*, copies of relevant *certified Academic Credentials* and naming **three referees**. Applications should be submitted with **at least two reference letters**
