- b). Clinical aspects of SCD/ Related NCDs and
- c). Psychosocial/ Ethical aspects of SCD/Related NCDs.
- d). Clinical/ Community Improvement project

#### Applicants should submit an application consisting of;

- Cover letter (1 Page)
- ➤ A Curriculum Vitae
- One (1) Recommendation letter from Professional Referee or Mentor.
- > 2 Page concept addressing SCD and related NCDs.

The research fellows will receive training in Bio-ethics, Implementation science, Behavioral sciences research, Qualitative and Quantitative research methodology, Data analysis and Research management. The review criteria for applicants will be as follows:

- Relevance to program objectives
- Quality of research/ Clinical/ Community project
- Feasibility of study/ Project
- Ethics and human subjects' protection.
