CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

BACKGROUND

- Makerere University College of Health Sciences (**MakCHS**) in partnership with the Sub-Saharan African Network for TB/HIV Research Excellence (**SANTHE**) Programme, with funding from the Developing Excellence in Leadership, Training and Science in Africa (DELTAS Africa) programme, seeks to fund one (1) candidate pursuing a Masters degree programme in biomedical sciences and any health related field with a research idea focused on TB elimination. **The candidate should be ready to complete their research in 18 months and submit a minimum of 1 manuscript from their work for publication in a peer-reviewed journal.**

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Applicants should hold a bachelor's degree in any health science discipline from a recognized University.
- Research idea related to TB, elimination in Africa including but not limited to disease prevention, better diagnosis, host pathogen interactions or responses strategies, immunology and microbiology.
- Applicants must be enrolled and actively pursuing a Masters' degree program at Makerere University.

The scholarship will cover Research Costs, and a monthly stipend for 18 months.



HOW TO APPLY

Required application documents include:

1. Application letter stating the motivations to pursue a research career and future aspirations.
2. A concept note (maximum of 2-pages) comprising; brief background, problem statement, aims of the project, methods and a budget.
3. Candidate's CV (maximum 3 pages) including proposed mentors/supervisors
4. Recommendation letters from two academic referees
5. Makerere University Admission letter for the Masters' degree program
6. Relevant academic transcripts/certificates
