Security Regulations for the 76th Graduation Ceremony

1. Invitation: Each graduand must bring only two guests to the graduation ground as permitted by the graduand invitation cards.
2. Prohibited items: The following items will be prohibited on the graduation grounds;
 - i) Fire arms
 - ii) Sharp instruments like mirrors, knives
 - iii) Alcohol
 - iv) Cells / batteries and chemicals
 - v) Canned food and drinks
 - vi) Laptops, flashes, and hard discs
 - vii) Pocket radios
 - viii) Bottled drinks
 - ix) Cameras (video and still cameras)
 - x) Large bags
 - xi) And any other dangerous weapons
3. Parking: The following categories of parking will be used for participants on graduation days:
 - i) VVIP and VIP parking (Directorate of legal parking, St Francis – St Augustine Church parking, JICA parking, senate Parking, CTF 1 and CTF 2 parking)
 - ii) General parking (Main sports ground and rugby ground)
 - iii) Other parking (HALLS of residence parking, Colleges Parking and estates and works parking)
 - iv) Staff Parking (Senate, CIT and Stanbic Bank Parking)
 - i) Access Control: Entrance to the graduation grounds will be through only three access points; Social Sciences check point
 - ii) Senate Check Point (NB: All media houses gadgets will be checked here)
 - iii) Swimming Pool Check point

For effective security management, all other routes to the venue will be cut off.
4. Makerere University issues graduand tags. The public is dissuaded from purchasing tags from elsewhere for the event as this is fraudulent.
5. Kindly note that only businesses accredited by the Senate Ceremonies Committee and security will be allowed to operate in gazetted places outside security check points. No business will be allowed to operate inside the graduation tent or beyond the check points.
